## What is Scouting About?

We all want our kids to be self-reliant, dependable, and caring; and since 1910, Scouting has been weaving these values into its programs. Through activities designed to help parents teach their sons how to make good decisions throughout their lives, Scouting helps them become the adult leaders of tomorrow.

## How Does It Work?

Boys attend meetings run by adult volunteers (Den Leaders) at which they work on earning awards for achieving specific goals. For example, the Bears (3rd graders) will work on Achievement #8 from the Cub Scout Bear Handbook, where they will learn about history through studying old almanacs & newspapers, study their own family trees, look at the history of their own community, and learn respect for people who grew up with values other than their own.

**Pack Meetings** - These meetings are held once per month to allow **all** the Cub Scouts (1st-5th grades) to gather for activities and information. The entire family is always invited!

**Den Meetings** - Dens are grouped by grade & meet 1-2 times per month. Families are encouraged to attend and participate in many of the activities. (See schedule at right)

## Where are Meetings Held?

Pack meetings are held in the Parkway School gym, and Den meetings are held in the cafeteria, teacher's lounge, or assigned classroom.

Each Cub Scout is asked to purchase a uniform shirt, scarf, neckerchief slide, and corresponding handbook, which can either be purchased at the Scout Store (330 S. 84th Street, Milwaukee 414-774-1776) or on-line at [scoutstuff.org](http://scoutstuff.org).

Most off-site events have minimal costs, but they are generally affordable because the pack offsets fees through two main fundraisers.

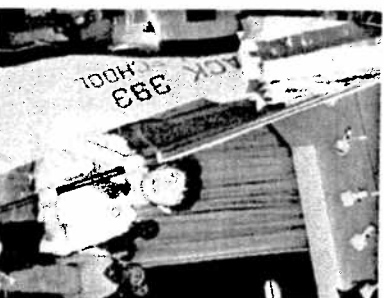
